75TH CHURCH ANNIVERSARY | APRIL 6 | 6-7:30PM | ELYRIA CAMPUS

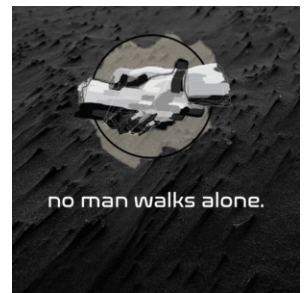

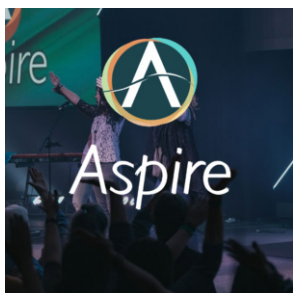
