Summary:

The Women's Ministry Director provides leadership and oversight for all women-related ministry, discipleship activities, outreach, and events across all campuses. She does so primarily by leading a Women's Ministry Team of volunteers at each campus. She is also the champion and liaison for Women's Ministry within the church and disciples women to follow Jesus, learn from Jesus, and become like Jesus.

Core Responsibilities:

- Oversee and champion Women's Ministry across all campuses.
- Pray for women in our congregation and communities.
- Lead, shepherd and disciple the Women's Ministry Leadership Team with representatives from each campus on a regular basis.
- Engage, recruit, and encourage Women's Ministry leaders across campuses.
- Foster a network and exchange of ideas and ministry opportunities among Women's Ministry volunteers across all campuses.
- Closely communicate with each Campus Pastor as well as the church at large for events and ministry initiatives.
- Assist as a sounding board to help leaders discern potential Bible studies and materials to disciple women at Open Door.
- Assist as the liaison and administrative coordinator for women ministry activities.
- Coordinate semi-annual programming to bring all women together across campuses (e.g. IF Conference, Worship Night, etc.).
- Oversee and manage the Women's Ministry budget, supplies, and annual goals.
