Luke 8:2-3

The Lord sovereignly **builds** His Kingdom.

The Kingdom of God: **Already** but **Not Yet**.

In the Kingdom, what matters is the **condition** of our hearts and the **obedience** of our lives.

You have a **PLACE** in the Kingdom of God.

- It's not by **accident**. You belong!

You have a **PURPOSE** in the Kingdom of God

- Jesus **invites** you to use your gifts, wirings, and resources to **further** the Kingdom.
